When bleak circumstances threaten to snuff out hope and obstacles test our resilience, those who create opportunity from difficulty emerge as heroes. The Orant Charities Africa 2024 Annual Report is a testament to the work and everyday heroism of our staff, the people we serve, and of our partners and supporters who stand with us in our mission. Through our work in Healthcare, Education, Water and Sanitation, Business Development, Agriculture, and Energy and Environment, Orant is transforming adversity into sustainable, locally driven progress for Malawi.

Throughout 2024, Orant's Healthcare Program provided critical, lifesaving care to 93,327 patients. Our Water and Sanitation Program drilled 10 new boreholes, and we completed our first piped water project, delivering clean and reliable access to water for 3,456 people. Our Education Program provided tuition for 114 students, and we proudly celebrated the graduation of 30. Through our Agriculture Program, we trained farmers in sustainable agricultural practices, resulting in nearly 2,000 pounds of crops planted. We expanded our Business Development Program to offer aspiring entrepreneurs and small businesses even greater levels of support. We launched our new Energy and Environment Program to address the effects of climate change and promote sustainable development.

In 2024, Orant Charities Africa changed and saved lives. And yet, our work continues. Malawi is still grappling with unimaginable difficulties. Periods of extended drought have devastated crops and threatened any degree of food security. Every day our clinicians are treating the effects of malnutrition, waterborne illnesses, and preventable diseases. Education for young women is an elusive dream. And too many families still live without access to clean sources of water.

And while these challenges are significant, we know they are not insurmountable. We know this because we have witnessed firsthand the heroes that walk amongst us. The tenacious who rise every day with a renewed hope for creating a better and brighter future.

At Orant Charities Africa, these heroes are not figures of myth or legend, they are our nurses, our students, our farmers, and our supporters. They are you. Hand in hand, we are providing a lifeline in the face of crisis. We are building a brighter tomorrow on a foundation of hope. What we accomplished in 2024 is a testament to what is possible, and it is only the beginning of what we will achieve going forward.
