1. Village Savings & Loans Annual Share-outs

- Sapeya: MK 2,546,000 (1468 USD)
- Kachigamba: MK 350,000 (201 USD)



Savings used for: School fees, Business expansion, Loan repayment, Asset purchases, e.t.c.

Mtambalika did not shareout



Saved MK 900,000 (519 USD) for future investments

2. Graduate members' Group projects

The following projects were initiated to support FEM members transitioning from the program:

- 37 baby hat & boot sets supplied to Kasese maternity ward
- Agribusiness expansion: 550 Kg maize purchased
 - Maize redistribution model to grow stock to 1,100 Kg
- Revolving fund balance: MK 617,714 (356 USD) supporting group enterprises
